MY ANALYSIS

My main motive for predicting the winner of Super Bowl LII was due to my own belief and knowledge of football. I consider myself a very avid football fan because I follow football very closely throughout the entire season.

Sadly, my prediction was very wrong for not only the score of the game, but also for who won. I predicted that the Patriots would win 24 - 17, while the real outcome of the game favored the Eagles by a score of 41 - 33.

I believed the Patriots were going to win primarily off of the fact that they have the greatest quarterback of all time under center, along with the greatest head coach of all time manning the helm (both my opinions). Tom Brady came back from a 25-point deficit during 2017's Super Bowl, and I believe Bill Belichick played a major role with helping Tom Brady succeed because of his halftime adjustments. WHY THE PATRIOTS LOST

I believe that the Patriots lost due to three key factors: Time of Possession, Rushing Attack, and 4th Down Efficiency.

Time of Possession -

The Eagles controlled the tempo of the football game from the very first snap all the way until the final whistle was blown. They had possession of the ball for over 34 minutes, which is over 56% of the entire game. This statistic allowed the Eagles to tire out the Patriots defense, which in turn was only able to force the Eagles to punt the ball one time.

Rushing Attack -

The rushing game for the Eagles was phenomenal throughout the game and accounted for 164 yards with an average of 6.1 yards per rush and one rushing touchdown. Both of those statistics are very impressive and played a major role in not only the Eagles' success, but also for why the Eagles possessed the ball for so much time during the game.

4th Down Efficiency –

Lastly, the Eagles were 2 for 2 on 4th down during the game, and both times they went for it on 4th down, it added major momentum for their team. One of the 4th down conversions in particular was deep in Patriots territory and they ended up scoring a touchdown on the play. If the Eagles would have failed to convert on 4th down, they not only would have lost possession of the ball, but they also would have lost an opportunity to at least kick a field goal and score three points.
