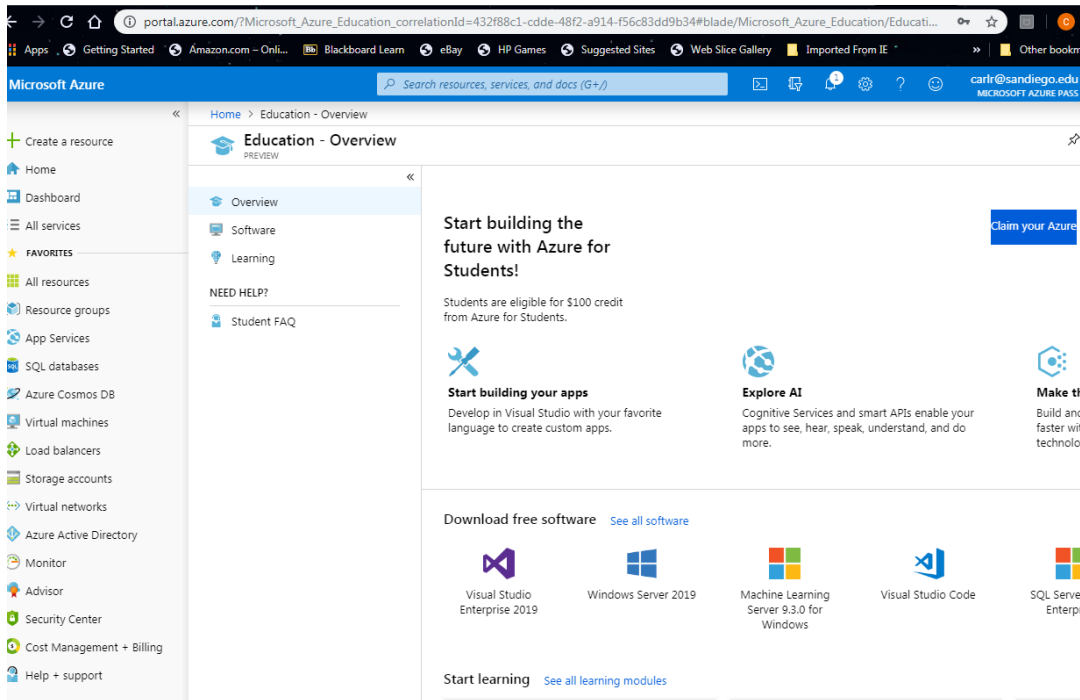


## DOWNLOADING WINDOWS OPERATING SOFTWARE FROM AZURE

After you have successfully logged in from (<https://azureforeducation.microsoft.com/devtools> ) you will see this screen.




You can then select either the software button option from the second vertical list, or you can click on download free software (see all software)
